This special issue of "Indian Journal of Archaeology (www.jjarch.org)" has only one article titled **"Catalogue of Gold Ring Currency, Gold Beads and Stone Beads Found from Mandi, District Muzaffarnagar, U.P., Currently Kept in U.P. State Museum"** by Vijay Kumar, Vinay Kumar Singh and Anita Chaurasiya gives the details of 2923 gold rings, 8 sets of rings joined together, 5 gold spacer beads, 5 conical terminal beads, 2 bell shaped terminal beads, 1 tabular bead, 2 onyx beads, 1 green stone bead, 2 variegated jasper beads, 9 ocean jasper beads, 11 river jasper beads and 14 silver bangles. It also suggests that the gold ring were used as currency as well as ornaments.



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
